S.R.O. 117—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution, the President hereby makes the following rules further to amend the Defence Accounts (Group 'C' and 'D' posts) Recruitment Rules, 1971, namely :—

1. (1) These rules may be called the Defence Accounts (Group 'C' and 'D' posts) Recruitment (Amendment) Rules, 1992.

(2) They shall be deemed to have come into force on the eleventh day of September, 1989.

2. In the Schedule Part-I Group 'C' service to the Defence Accounts (Group 'C' and 'D' posts). Recruitment Rules, 1971 (hereinafter referred to as the said Schedule) serial number 5 relating to the post of Junior Key Punch Operator and entries thereto shall be omitted.

3. In the said Schedule—

(i) after serial number 1B relating to the post of Hindi Translator Gd. II and entries thereto, the following shall be inserted, namely :—
