## OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Sub: - Central Civil services (Classification, Control and appeal) Rules, 1965 - appeal in the case of a disciplinary order against an office bearer of an association or union in respect of activities as such office bearer - Disposal of.

Attention of the Ministry of Finance etc. is invited to this Ministry's Netification No.7/4/64-Ests.(A) dated the 18th April, 1967 inserting a new sub-rule to rule 24 of the Central Civil Services (Classification, Control and Appeal) Rules, 1965, providing that an appeal against an order imposing any benalty specified in rule 11 of the said Rules shall lie to the president, where no such appeal lies to him under sub-rules (1) and (2) of rule 24, if such penalty is imposed by an authority other than the president, on a Government servant in respect of his activities connected with his work as an office bearer of an association or union participating in the Joint Consultation and Compulsory Arbitration Scheme. It is clarified that all appeals to the President under this provision should be placed before the Minister-in-charge for final orders, irrespective of whether the general directions in various Ministries, relating to the disposal of appeals addressed to the president require such submission or not.

- 2. In respect of persons serving in the Indian Audit and Accounts Department, the appeals referred to in the preceding para shall be disposed of by the Comptroller and Auditor General of India.
- 3. The above instructions may be brought to the notice of all concerned.
